## Joy of Being a Christian

In the book of Philippians one of the themes Paul focuses on is the pursuit of joy. However, before we can pursue joy we must understand what this joy is.

What does a joyous person look like? How do you tell a joyous person from a person who is just happy about something? If you are a Giants fan you are happy your team won the super bowl! Today many people turn to substances to help them be happy.

However, joy is something that is unaffected by outward circumstances. It is a state of mind and an orientation of the heart. Joy is deep. It is a settled state of contentment, confidence and hope. Philippians helps us understand some of the characteristics of Christian joy.

Believers have a shared joy. In Paul's opening words: "I thank my God every time I remember you. In all my prayers for all of you, I always pray with joy because of your partnership in the gospel from the first day until now.... It is right for me to feel this way about all of you, since I have you in my heart; for whether I am in chains or defending and confirming the gospel, all of you share in God's grace with me. God can testify how I long for all of you with the affection of Christ Jesus." Philippians 1:3-5, 7-8

Paul tells the Philippians that he has been praying for them. But he doesn't just pray, he prays with joy. And his joy comes "because of your partnership in the gospel". Paul's joy is a shared joy. This partnership is more than just spending time together — there is a unity, a joy, a purpose that is held in common.

Those things that bring us joy are things we share with others. We just returned from Disney World with our family. I am sure you will get tired of hearing about our trip, but it was a great experience and we want to share it with others. Christian joy is a deeper joy and one that you cannot help but share with others. As Christians we share:

**A common grace.** There are many things that divide us. We divide over politics, ethnic issues, gender differences, and personal tastes and interests. But when we come to Christ there is a bond with others that transcends differences. That bond is God's grace.

A common burden. Jesus has called us all to do the same thing: glorify Him in our living and testify of Him to our friends and neighbors. We may disagree on the issues of gun control, abortion, the death penalty, and many other issues, but we do agree that there is only one way for people to get to Heaven. We agree that there is only one hope for modern society, and that one way and one hope is Jesus. We are people working together to get the message out. We work together in this privileged and joyful task.
