## WHAT IS THE TRUTH?

In questioning Jesus, Pilate asked the question: "what is the truth? "(John 18:38) This is a question that transcends time and reaches even unto this day. Many today are asking the same question. Some have arrived at what is believed to be the answer. Others are still looking. Let us examine for a minute what the truth is not. In so doing, perhaps we can determine what is the truth.

The truth is not based on just man's opinion. One man stated, "Opinions are like noses, everybody has one." There may be much truth in that simple statement. The fact is, opinion is like the wind; it can change with different conditions. Many have opinions, but not

all opinions are truth. There are basically two kinds of opinion. There are subjective opinion and objective. Subjective opinions are usually based on feelings, notions, ideas, and past experiences. Sometimes these opinions are fueled by feelings at a given moment in time. Objective opinions, however, are based on fact.
