The first guy immediately responds, “I would like to hear them say that I was one of the great doctors of my time, and a great family man.”

The second guy says, “I would like to hear that I was a wonderful husband and school teacher who made a huge difference in the children of tomorrow.”

The last guy thinks a minute and replies, “I guess I’d like to hear them say, ‘Look, he’s moving!’”

Many are very reluctant to leave this life and want to hold on to it at all costs. Do we realize what heaven is really like? No one who really understands the beauty and wonders of heaven would ever be reluctant to leave this earth and go there.

Heaven is a spiritual place but God describes it to us in physical terms since we can’t really understand spiritual beauty. Revelation 21:4 *“And God will wipe away every tear from their eyes; there shall be no more death, nor sorrow, nor crying. But if I live on in the flesh, this will mean fruit from my labor; yet what I shall choose I cannot tell. So we are always confident, knowing that while we are at home in the body we are absent from the Lord. For we walk by faith, not by sight. We are confident, yes, well pleased rather to be absent from the body and to be present with the Lord.”*
