Responsibility

"Little Emily ran into the house, crying as though her heart would break. 'What's wrong, dear?' asked her father. 'My doll! Billy broke it!' she sobbed. 'How did he break it, Emily?' 'I hit him over the head with it.'"

That's about the way many people today try to get away from accepting responsibility for their actions. It doesn't matter what happens to them, it's always someone else's fault.

We may get away with those excuses and blame here on earth but when we stand before God in judgment, we will have to accept responsibility for our actions.

God is all-seeing and all-knowing and we will not be able to fool Him in blaming someone else for our actions.

Each of us will answer for our own sins when we stand before God in judgment. Ezekiel 18:20 The soul who sins shall die. The son shall not bear the guilt of the father, nor the father bear the guilt of the son. The righteousness of the righteous shall be upon himself, and the wickedness of the wicked shall be upon himself.

As Christians the good we have done in the past will not protect us if we turn back to a life of sin. Ezekiel 18:24 *"But when the righteous turneth away from his righteousness, and committeth iniquity, and doeth according to all the abominations that the wicked man doeth, shall he live? All his righteousness that he hath done shall not be mentioned: in his trespass that he hath trespassed, and in his sin that he hath sinned, in them shall he die."*

God promises that if we turn from our sins, He will forgive us. Ezekiel 18:21-23 *"But if the wicked will turn from all his sins that he hath committed, and keep all my statutes, and do that which is lawful and right, he shall surely live, he shall not die. All his transgressions that he hath committed, they shall not be mentioned unto him: in his righteousness that he hath done he shall live. Have I any pleasure at all that the wicked should die? saith the Lord God: and not that he should return from his ways, and live?"*

If you have not repented of sin in your life, it is my prayer that you will do so, before it is too late.
