PREACHING IN LOVE

As Paul discoursed on righteousness, self-control and the judgment to come, Felix was afraid and said, "That's enough for now! You may leave. When I find it convenient, I will send for you."

Acts 24:25 Sounds like Paul was preaching a little fire and brimstone! At the very least, Felix got the idea that Paul thought he was going to have to pack the asbestos jammies for the big sleep! Every so often someone will get a funny look on their face during a Bible study, look at me and ask, "Do you think I'm going to hell?" While I try to be as tactful as possible, there is no getting around the fact that, most of the time, I am studying with the person for precisely that reason! It is the serious consequences of sin and the great salvation that is ours in Christ Jesus that should motivate us to a little "fire and brimstone!" I'm not talking about scaring people just to manipulate them, or brow-beating people into submission with dire threats of eternal consequences if they don't "tow the line." I'm talking about telling people that an infinitely just, powerful, and benevolent God exists and takes interest in each person's life.

When Paul began to preach the truth about the righteousness of God, the self-control that is part and parcel to a life pleasing to Him, and the judgment reserved for those who refuse His generous offer, it naturally scared the willies out of Felix! It is the same word that offers the freedom of salvation in Christ that condemns the alien sinner to eternal punishment. People need to hear both sides. People need to know they are lost before they want to be saved, and people need to know they can be saved before they will be concerned about being lost. Let's just take the apostle's example, preach the truth in love, and let the Spirit do His work.
