Services in Building Resume Sunday

After much review, discussion, and prayer, we are announcing the commencement of AM worship services at the building, beginning again on June 21st. Initially we will gather for AM worship at 11:00 and will continue to evaluate the resuming of Sunday and Wednesday Bible classes and Sunday PM Service.

Everyone views disease and sickness differently, even before this pandemic. On one extreme, some have no issue with being around and in close contact with those who are sick, while others become so concerned with disease that they will not leave their homes. Most of us do not fall into either one of these two specific categories, but we all have our views of what is the correct amount of precautions to use in dealing with disease.

It is requested that everyone please take your body temperature before you leave home. If you have a fever, please stay home, even if you feel well. If you don't feel well, but have no fever, please stay at home. Please let us know so we can be praying for your health.

COVID-19 should only be a physical issue, let us all work together to not let it become a divisive spiritual issue.

We are making the following adjustments for when we once again assemble at the building.

We ask that each family space six feet from others when you take your seats. If you sit on one end of a pew then the people sitting in front of you and behind you should be sitting at the other end of their pews. It may require some adjustment so that people on the inside aisle are not directly across from each other.

For dismissal so that people are not walking past each other please exit starting with the back row as you would see

done at a wedding. Patiently await those behind you to exit before you. It is sad that this impacts on our family fellowship, but for the time being it is for the best. As you exit the auditorium please continue to observe "social distancing".

These not in any order of importance as we believe each action to be of equal Greeting: Tom importance, please note the following.

We will be using single serving communion cups for the time being. They will **Opening Hymn**: be handed to you by a designated person wearing gloves as you enter the auditori421—Where the Gates Swing um. Each serving will be in a plastic bag which you can use to contain the empty Outward Never service after completion of the Lord's Supper. A trash bin will be at the entry of Opening Prayer: the auditorium for you to drop your empties in as you leave.

It has been decided for the next few weeks to have a box on the side table in the back for you to deposit your contribution when you enter or when you leave. "Please continue to observe "social distancing".

For the next few weeks to help limit the time we are in the building, Bible Study will be moved to Zoom virtual meeting at 6:00 pm on Sunday.

It is strongly recommended that everyone wear masks while in the building. Although they can be uncomfortable, health guidelines show they are helpful in protecting others.

Our plan is to have some available. If you do not bring one ask the person passing out the communion kits.

No hugs, shaking hands, kissing, etc. Please do your best to observe the social Dale distancing guidelines provided by the CDC and medical community (6 feet).

Restrooms will be provided with sanitizing wipes. Please dispose of any you 147—Jesus Hold My Hand use in the trash can.

The classrooms are a "no access area" for the time being.

The goal remains the same as it was when the decision was made to move worship to individual homes and virtual connectivity; keep everyone safe and Closing Hymn: healthy.

There has never been a situation like this in our lifetime. Please continue your prayers for the Lord's church as well as our state and country's leaders.
