Is the first thing that comes to mind perhaps the Sunday celebration of "Father's Day" where you take/took the time to travel to his house and present to him your gifts of love, gratitude, and appreciation? You see, after all He's done for us, our heavenly Father is far too special to celebrate only occasionally or annually. Every first day of the week is our heavenly Father's Day! Let us be determined not to miss it for the world!
